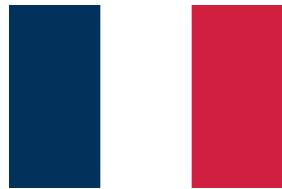

Coordinated Retirement Schemes

Issues of primary concern

Pensions Funds

- **AEIP Commission II - Pension funds (supplementary to the State pensions “pillar 2”)**
- **Mobility of workers within the EU and protection of social rights (cross border pensions, portability of social rights, risks of social dumping)**
- **Supervision – EIOPA and the revision of the IORP Directive (Directive on the supervision and activities of institutions of occupational retirement provision)**
- **Solvency Rules or Safety Rules for Occupational Pensions**

- **Balance between DC, DB schemes**
- **Solidarity the benefits of mandatory collective schemes**



Issues of primary concern

Healthcare

- **AEIP Commission III - Healthcare institutions (providing healthcare benefits)**
- **Analyze the social and economic issues surrounding **long term care** by looking at institutions and independent living**
- **Discussed issues such as cross border health care as well as the link between health, pensions and housing**
- **Best practices regarding staff in the healthcare sector**
